




## Collaboration for Evidence-Based Healthcare and Public Health in Africa

The population of Sub-Saharan Africa is increasingly burdened by non-communicable diseases. There is, however, a lack of information on the scale of and potential solutions to this burden in Africa. By establishing long-term capacity and infrastructure for evidence-based health care and evidence-based public health, the CEBHA+ consortium, together with decision-makers, aims to support the production and translation of meaningful research results into the development, implementation and evaluation of priority health interventions in Sub-Saharan Africa. Specifically, partners focus on generating high quality research on diabetes, hypertension and road traffic injuries.



The population of Sub-Saharan Africa is affected by a considerable disease burden. In addition to infectious diseases, non-communicable diseases such as diabetes, hypertension and accidental injuries are the main causes for illness and death. Inadequate human resources, a weak health care infrastructure and limited supply capacities confront Sub-Saharan Africa with enormous challenges.

The overarching goal of the African-German research network CEBHA+ is to establish long-term capacity and infrastructure for evidence-based healthcare and public health in sub-Saharan Africa. The consortium intends to strengthen African research institutions as well as to build competence in the understanding and rapid uptake of evidence in health system institutions. CEBHA+ adopts a population perspective which encompasses both preventive and curative health care.
